Oarsome Voyage

Once upon a time there were five young men from Ballinalismore Surf Club who decided they would row surf boats. Brian Sidney, Warren Tulk, Lance Goldsmith, Cec Denny and Max Sidney undertook the task with great skill and



dedication, winning many local titles in addition to three Australian Surf Boat Championships – 66/67, 67/68, 68/69 and placing second in 69/70.

When the crew retired, they cut the shaft off their oars (paddles) and painted their names and winning details on the blade of each oar. Brian Sidney's piece of this rowing memorabilia was housed in his Lismore home for many years until the recent floods floated it away along with many other treasured household items. One afternoon when the skies had cleared and flood waters had subsided, Ballina local, Leonie Dahl, was clearing debris from underneath her jetty on the Richmond River. Wild waters had left much flotsam wedged underneath and amongst the items found was Brian's valuable oar blade. The distance by river from Lismore to Ballina is approximately 100 kilometres, meaning the item had been on an amazing maritime adventure.

Leonie contacted me, as an ex Surf Club member, and I arranged for it to be given to the Surf Club. Brian has since generously donated this piece of local history to the Club. So, what an amazing voyage for this great piece of local history.
