

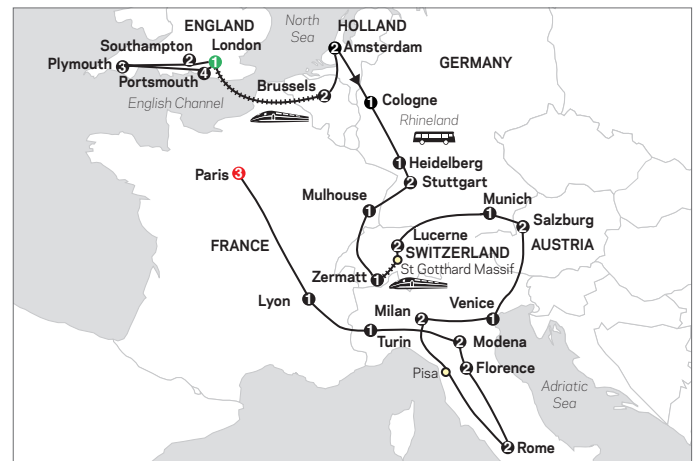

40 day itinerary

DAY 1 FRIDAY 29 AUGUST 2025 ARRIVE LONDON, ENGLAND

On arrival at the airport, you will be met by your Tour Director and transferred to your hotel. Welcome dinner this evening. (D)

DAY 2 SATURDAY 30 AUGUST LONDON - SOUTHAMPTON AREA

Enjoy a sightseeing tour that includes all of London's famous landmarks. Drive past the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben; Westminster Abbey; Whitehall's mounted horseguards; the Prime Minister's Downing Street; Piccadilly Circus; and Buckingham Palace. Take photographs of the London Eye, the giant Ferris wheel situated on the riverbank, and the Shard. In the afternoon we travel from London to the Southampton area. (B)

DAY 3 SUNDAY 31 AUGUST LONDON - SOUTHAMPTON AREA

Visit Beaulieu, where you can explore the National Motor Museum, World of Top Gear, Palace House & Gardens, Beaulieu Abbey, The Secret Army Exhibition, Little Beaulieu and unlimited rides on the Monorail & Veteran Bus. You will also have time to visit the International Auto Jumble. (B)

DAY 4 MONDAY 1 SEPTEMBER SOUTHAMPTON AREA - STONEHENGE - PLYMOUTH

Depart for Stonehenge the world-famous mysterious ring of standing stones. Travel on through Salisbury Plain into Dartmoor. Stop in Widecombe-in-the-Moor with its prominent church, cozy tea rooms, and lively pubs before arriving in Plymouth. (B, D)

DAY 5 TUESDAY 2 SEPTEMBER PLYMOUTH

A day full of West Country sights as you head through Cornwall, of Poldark fame. After viewing St. Michael's Mount, take time to explore the popular seaside resort of St. Ives. Then, follow in the footsteps of Drake, Raleigh, and the Pilgrim Fathers with a cruise on Plymouth Sound, one of the world's great natural harbors. You will also have time at the historic Plymouth Barbican to see the Mayflower Steps. (B)

DAY 6 WEDNESDAY 3 SEPTEMBER PLYMOUTH

Day at leisure. (B)

DAY 7 THURSDAY 4 SEPTEMBER PLYMOUTH - GLASTONBURY - PORTSMOUTH AREA

Visit the lively town of Glastonbury and hear about King Arthur who is said to be buried here. Afterwards, visit the famous Haynes International Motor Museum in Yeovil, Somerse. Continue to Portsmouth. (B,D)

DAY 8 FRIDAY 5 SEPTEMBER PORTSMOUTH AREA

Attend the Goodwood Revival Festival. (B)

DAY 9 SATURDAY 6 SEPTEMBER PORTSMOUTH AREA

Attend the Goodwood Revival Festival. (B)

DAY 10 SUNDAY 7 SEPTEMBER PORTSMOUTH AREA

Attend the Goodwood Revival Festival. (B)

DAY 11 MONDAY 8 SEPTEMBER PORTSMOUTH AREA, LONDON - BRUSSELS, BELGIUM

Transfer to the rail station for the Eurostar service to Brussels. On arrival in Brussels, you will be met by your Tour Director and transferred to your hotel. Join your Tour Director for a welcome drink at the hotel bar. (B)

DAY 12 TUESDAY 9 SEPTEMBER BRUSSELS

Explore this vibrant city, headquarters of the European Union. Along the way, hear about the ornate Grand Place and see the tiny yet world-famous Manneken Pis statue. The afternoon is free to make your own discoveries. (B)

DAY 13 WEDNESDAY 10 SEPTEMBER BRUSSELS - ANTWERP - AMSTERDAM, HOLLAND

Cross the border into Holland and arrive in Antwerp. Discover the international port city of Antwerp on a guided tour. See the

centuries-old Diamond Quarter, the Royal Academy of Fine Arts, the 14th-century Cathedral of Our Lady, and much more. (B)

DAY 14 THURSDAY 11 SEPTEMBER AMSTERDAM

Explore Amsterdam and see the city highlights, followed by a canal cruise to see the city from water level, then stop to watch the cutting and polishing of precious stones at a Diamond Center. (B)

DAY 15 FRIDAY 12 SEPTEMBER AMSTERDAM - COLOGNE, GERMANY

Travel to Cologne and visit the impressive 13th century gothic cathedral (one of the largest in Europe). (B)

DAY 16 SATURDAY 13 SEPTEMBER COLOGNE - NURBURG - HEIDELBERG

Visit the Nurburg Ring motorsports complex for the day and continue to Heidelberg. (B)

DAY 17 SUNDAY 14 SEPTEMBER HEIDELBERG - STUTTART

This morning enjoy a guided walking tour around in the Old Town, then ride the funicular up the hill and visit the red-walled Castle. Continue on to Stuttgart. (B)

DAY 18 MONDAY 15 SEPTEMBER STUTTART

Today visit the Porsche Museum for a factory tour. The rest of the afternoon is Stuttgart to explore the city. (B)

DAY 19 TUESDAY 16 SEPTEMBER STUTTART - MULHOUSE, FRANCE

This morning visit the iconic Mercedes Benz Museum and Factory. In the afternoon journey to Mulhouse. Visit one of the largest automobile museums in the world - the Cité de l'Automobile. You are guided through to the next area by projections of motorcars in the Museum which move along at your pace. (B)

DAY 20 WEDNESDAY 17 SEPTEMBER MULHOUSE - BERN - ZERMATT AREA - SWITZERLAND

Depart France, travel through some of the

country's best farmland to the Swiss capital, Berne, see Bear Park and the Federal Palace. Along the way, take photos of the Jungfrau massif with its three legendary peaks: Jungfrau, Mönch, and Eiger. Later we continue to Interlaken and cross Brünig Pass. (B)

DAY 21 THURSDAY 18 SEPTEMBER ZERMATT AREA - LUCERNE

Today, another highlight of your tour: the world-renowned Glacier Express, board Switzerland's most famous mountain railway. Ride the Glacier Express from Andermatt to Zermatt at the St. Gotthard massif. Rejoin your motorcoach for Lucerne. (B)

DAY 22 FRIDAY 19 SEPTEMBER: LUCERNE

Discover the wonders of Lucerne, a city straight out of a storybook. Situated on Lake Lucerne beneath the snowcapped Alps. Cruise Lake Lucerne taking in the looming mountains of the snowy Swiss Alps, forested hillsides and the hive of activity of the lake. (B)

DAY 23 SATURDAY 20 SEPTEMBER LUCERN - MUNICH, GERMANY

Depart Switzerland on our scenic drive of alpine villages and snow-capped mountains towards Munich. Enroute visit Neuschwanstein and enjoy a guided visit of the world's most famous fairytale castle: King Ludwig II's incomparable Neuschwanstein. Please note this visit is subject to availability. This evening in Munich, enjoy traditional Bavarian cuisine at the famous Hofbrauhaus. (B,D)

DAY 24 SUNDAY 21 SEPTEMBER MUNICH - SALZBURG, AUSTRIA

Visit Marienplatz. Continue through the beautiful Bavarian countryside via the Lake Chiemsee. Continue to Salzburg though the town of Berchtesgaden Germany to visit the Kehlsteinhaus (Eagle's nest). A Third Reich building erected atop the summit of Kehlstein. (B)

DAY 25 MONDAY 22 SEPTEMBER SALZBURG

See the highlights of the historical center, including the Domplatz, the Festival Hall with the former Horse Trough, and, of course, the charming Getreidegasse. (B)

DAY 26 TUESDAY 23 SEPTEMBER SALZBURG -VENICE AREA, ITALY

Today transverse the beautiful Austrian Alps before arriving in Venice area in the late afternoon. (B)

DAY 27 WEDNESDAY 24 SEPTEMBER VENICE AREA - MILAN

Explore Venice. Your included orientation features a boat ride to St. Mark's Square and a visit to a Venetian Glassblowing Workshop. (B)

DAY 28 THURSDAY 25 SEPTEMBER MILAN - LA SPEZIA AREA - MILAN

Visit the Alfa Romeo Museum. This evening, enjoy wandering the streets with a guided night tour of the port city La Spezia (B)

DAY 29 FRIDAY 26 SEPTEMBER LA SPEZIA AREA - PISA - ROME

Stop in Pisa to enjoy a mini-train ride to the Square of Miracles and see the legendary Leaning Tower. (B)

DAY 30 SATURDAY 27 SEPTEMBER ROME

Start your guided introduction to Rome from St. Peter's Square, and see other highlights such as the Colosseum and Circus Maximus. (B)

DAY 31 SUNDAY 28 SEPTEMBER ROME - FLORENCE

Depart Rome and continue north to Florence. Vistas of rolling hills, cypress trees, terraced vineyards, olive groves, and charming villages form the backdrop as you journey through the heart of Tuscany. (B)

DAY 32 MONDAY 29 SEPTEMBER FLORENCE

The city of the Medicis will keep you enthralled the entire day. Wander at leisure and see the city highlights, Piazza Santa Croce; Piazza Signoria; Palazzo Vecchio; Loggia dei Lanzi; and, Piazza del Duomo and its cathedral with the Giotto Campanile, and the magnificent East Door of the Baptistery. (B)

DAY 33 TUESDAY 30 SEPTEMBER FLORENCE - MODENA

Depart Florence and enroute to Modena enjoy lunch at a family run restaurant located just outside Bologna for a traditional Spaghetti Bolognese or Tagliatelle. On arrival in Modena, see the sites the city focusing on the Romanesque cathedral, the bell tower, and the octagonal baptistry. (B,L)

DAY 34 WEDNESDAY 1 OCTOBER MODENA; EXCURSION TO THE FERRARI FACTORY & MUSEUM, LAMBORGHINI FACTORY

The Ferrari Museum in Maranello offers visitors exclusive shuttle bus tours to the Fiorano track and along the Viale Enzo Ferrari boulevard in the factory complex. A museum guide will also discuss the various characteristics of the Ferrari track where the Prancing Horse has carried out all its competition and road car tests since 1972. In the afternoon take a guided tour of the production lines. (B)

DAY 35 THURSDAY 2 OCTOBER MODENA, MASERATI FACTORY - TURIN

Visit the headquarters of the Italian ultra-luxury car designer the Maserati. Take an exclusive factory tour that includes a welcome reception and historical introduction in the recently renovated showrooms prior to a guided walk around the assembly line. Afterwards there is the opportunity to view the cars and browse

through the Maserati store. Depart for Turin and visit the royal chapel of the Cathedral of Saint John the Baptist in Turin and see the Shroud of Turin. (B)

DAY 36 FRIDAY 3 OCTOBER TURIN- GRENOBLE - LYON, FRANCE

Visit the Museo Nazionale dell 'Automobile in Turin. Continue to Grenoble, France's self-styled 'Capital of the Alps' and then onto Lyon. (B)

DAY 37 SATURDAY 4 OCTOBER LYON- PARIS, FRANCE

Visit the famous Hotel-Dieu and we continue to explore the very heart of the Burgundy wine-growing region, making a stop in lovely Beaune, surrounded by some of the world's finest vineyards. (B)

DAY 38 SUNDAY 5 OCTOBER PARIS; EXCURSION TO THE RENAULT MUSEUM
