It was sold by 'Robb Motors' in Capetown, South Africa (pictured) and the company plate remains affixed to the dashboard.




We don't know when it came to Australia but believe that it may be the only one in the country. Our understanding is that in 2000 it was found pretty much a wreck on a farm in N.S.W. It was recovered and taken to Perth where over 5 years it was restored and subsequently used as club car. Some years later it was purchased from a dealer in Adelaide and made its way to Kancoona in North-East Victoria where it was also a club car at Bright.

We purchased the car in 2015 and have done considerable work to improve its look and performance.

With the expertise of Wodonga mechanic Wayne Talay of Wayne Talay Motors, the engine, clutch, gearbox and fuel system have all been completely overhauled and the car is running smoothly. Wayne has restored a number of classic vehicles of his own and is extremely knowledgeable and meticulous. He was very generous in sharing his knowledge and taught Andy a great deal.

The fuel tank had deteriorated beyond repair and unable to source a genuine replacement, we turned to local engineer and car enthusiast of some repute, Trevor Newton. He designed and manufactured a new tank for us, one of the few non genuine parts we have had to install.







The interior of the car was largely complete but we were able to source genuine items from both Studebaker Australia and various companies in America. We fitted front door arm rests, a radio delete plate, radio grille, an ash-tray and vent window handles. We bought a genuine exterior windscreen divider, engineer Trevor Newton manufactured the interior divider and a wind-screen repairer carried out the installation. The clock was not working but a chance conversation led us to a retired auto clock repairer living in Wodonga. He sent to England for some parts and successfully restored the clock.







In Victoria we were members of 'Murray Heritage Motorists' club and enjoyed many outings with a great group of people and a most interesting collection of vehicles. In 2020 we relocated to Coffs Harbour and joined the CEX Car Club where our adventures with the 'Champion' have continued. Thanks to Steve Woods expertise and generosity the old clutch was replaced and all is running smoothly again.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING SUNDAY 14th AUGUST 2022 @ C.EX WOOLGOOLGA MINUTES OF THE MEETING

OPENING OF THE MEETING

President opened the meeting 10.35am and welcomed attendees.

OPENING VIDEO A video titled "2022 THE YEAR IN REVIEW" was shown which included photos of all club events held since the last AGM 12th December 2021. Secretary congratulated the Events Co-Ordinator on a great effort by organising 21 successful events, despite the challenges of Covid-19 and the unpredictable weather.

Secretary commented that all monthly Committee Meetings and monthly General (Members) Meetings were held, including the NSW Historic Motoring Association North Coast Roadshow which attracted the largest attendances of the Regional Roadshows.

ATTENDANCE

34 financial members attended, and the names have been recorded in the Attendance Register. Also, 14 partners and 1 visitor were in attendance making a total of 49 at the AGM.

INTRODUCTIONS

New member Sam Mowat was introduced by the President. Sam addressed the meeting and was accompanied by his father who attended as a visitor.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING AND BUSINESS ARISING

Secretary advised the last Annual General Meeting was held on 12th December 2021 and a copy of the Minutes was published in the January 2022 edition of the Club Newsletter. A copy of the minutes was also tabled at the meeting for the information of members in attendance. Secretary declared there was no business arising and moved the minutes of the previous AGM 12th December 2021 be accepted and requested a Seconder

SECONDED BY PAT O'CARROLL

PRESENTATION OF THE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT Treasurer presented an overhead slide of the 2021-2022 Income & Expenditure. Treasurer commented on the report and asked if there were any questions from the floor. No questions were raised. Treasurer moved the report be accepted and requested a Seconder. **SECONDED BY DICK WILLIS**

INTRODUCION OF THE ELECTION PROCESS

President stressed the importance of members stepping up as Committee Members or Office Bearers to support their club and encouraged members to consider the changes Committee has made to the Secretary's position which enables the workload to be shared more equitably across the membership.

ELECTION OF COMMITTEE

Secretary displayed an overhead slide showing the Management Structure and provided a detailed explanation of how the Secretary's position has been split into three separate roles to lessen the workload. Secretary endorsed the President's remarks of encouraging members to consider nominating for these new positions. These positions would only require a 12 month tenure and would include training and support by the outgoing Secretary for 6 months, if required.

Secretary advised the car club was now in a very stable position with ongoing support provided by C.ex Coffs, an increasing membership base with interesting cars, and a great variety of event being provided by the Events Committee. Secretary further remarked that with a little more support from members our club, with 22 years history, would continue to remain in operation for many more years to come.

Secretary then requested the Returning Officer to take the chair.

Welcome everyone to the C.ex Coffs Sports Touring & Classic Car Club 2022 Annual General Meeting.
