### CHANGES TO THE CAR CLUB BY-LAWS

An overhead slide showing the existing By-Laws and the proposed changes was explained by Club President, Pat O'Carroll and opened for questions from the floor.

Bob Harris enquired as to the current number of members. Acting Secretary displayed an excel spreadsheet on overhead slide confirming current membership was 81, with a few other applications awaiting approval.

A vote was then held, and the result was in favour, and unanimous. The proposed changes had also been approved by C.ex Coffs Board, subject to a majority vote by car club financial members.

It was then moved the changes be implemented immediately and uploaded to the car club website.

#### **COMMITTEE ELECTIONS**

Club Member, Dick Willis introduced himself as the club appointed Returning Officer and welcomed everyone to the C.ex Coffs Sports Touring & Classic Car Club 2025 Annual General Meeting. He thanked the outgoing Committee and Officer Bearers for their contribution to our club over the past year. He then directed all existing Committee Members to stand down and declared all positions vacant.

He confirmed the Car Club Newsletter, Idle Torque, was emailed to members on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025 and included the 2025 AGM Agenda and 2025-2026 Committee Nomination Form. He further advised the Car Club is required, under the C.ex Coffs "Rules for Operation", to fill the following minimum number of positions in order for the Car Club to operate as a Sub-Club of C.ex Coffs. President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and a minimum of one Committee Member from a maximum allowed of 4.

Nominations from the floor were requested and as no further nominations were received, a slide was displayed showing all current nominations, proposers, and seconders.

Dick moved the 2025 AGM election process be accepted as completed in terms of the C.ex Coffs Rules and extended his congratulations to the new Committee. He thanked everyone for their participation and wished the Car Club well in 2026. Pat O'Carroll thanked the outgoing Secretary, Tom Craven, and outgoing Treasurer, Mike Gosbell, for their good work over the last year. Pat also acknowledged the following members who are taking on new roles, Secretary David Kennedy, Treasurer Warwick Thomson, Committee Member Craig Dandeaux, Publicity Officer Bob Harris, Newletter Editor Steve Horsfall, and Events Committee Ken Stanley.

Club President, Pat O'Carroll declared the 2025 AGM closed and thanked everyone for their attendance.

# C.EX COFFS SPORTS, TOURING & CLASSIC CAR CLUB CLUB BY-LAWS (As Amended 3rd August 2025)

### **MEMBERSHIP**

1. Applications for membership must be submitted using the car club's standard *Application for Membership Form,* and the applicant must attend a car club General Meeting for introduction before their application can be processed.

#### **CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION**

- **2**. Any applications for Conditional Registration (be it HVS or CVS) must be made in accordance with the guidelines and instructions set down by the NSW Historic Motoring Association and approvals will be subject to the Transport for NSW rules and regulations.
- **3**. Conditional Registration is considered a privilege and is granted on the basis that those members will actively participate in car club events on a regular basis. New members must attend at least two (2) club events before applying for either HVS or CVS conditional registration, club monthly meeting do count as an event for this purpose.
- **4**. Annual renewal of Conditional Registration is the discretion of the car club Committee and will be considered based on the members involvement with the car club over the past year, and their individual circumstances.
- **5**. Members must provide copies of their Conditional Registration papers for vehicles registered under the Historic Vehicle Scheme and the Classic Vehicle Scheme to the Club Registration Administrator on initial registration and on renewal, within seven days of the registration date.
- **6**. Registration Administrators and Registration Inspectors are not authorised to complete, sign off on, or process, any documentation in relation to conditional registration for vehicles where they are the registered owner.
- **7**. Any modifications and other alterations made to the vehicle after inspections for HVS and CVS must be immediately notified to the Registration Administrator.






